Dr. L.F. Andrews completed orthodontic training at Ohio State University in 1958. He is the inventor of the Straight-Wire-Appliance System and discoverer of the Six Keys to Normal (Optimal) Occlusion and the Six Elements of Orofacial Harmony. In 1989 he authored the textbook Straight-Wire The Concept and Appliance“. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics, a clinical professor at Bauru Dental School, University of Sao Paulo, Brazil. He is the Co-Director of the Andrews Foundation for Orthodontic Education and Research and Editor for the Andrews Journal of Orthodontics and Orofacial Harmony. In 2005 he was the recipient of the PCSO Lifetime Achievement Award. He has lectured worldwide about the Six Elements Orthodontic Philosophy and maintains a private practice limited to orthodontics and orofacial harmony in San Diego, California



Will A. Andrews, D.D.S.

Dr. W. Andrews completed orthodontic training at the University of California at San Francisco (UCSF) in 1992. He is a Diplomate of the American Board on Orthodontics, a member of the Edward H. Angle Society of Orthodontists, an assistant clinical Professor at UCSF and a visiting professor at Bauru Dental School, University of Sao Paulo, Brazil. He is the Co-Director of the Andrews Foundation for Orthodontic Education an Research and Research Editor for the Andrews Journal of Orthodontics and Orofacial Harmony.
